LANGUAGE TRAINING

French as a Foreign Language for professional purposes

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

Acquire the language and social skills required for written and oral daily, professional and citizen interactions.

TARGET AUDIENCE

- · Non-French-speaking RSA beneficiaries having trouble in professional integration.
- People who have signed the Republican Integration Contract (CIR) with the OFII less than 5
 years ago.

PREREQUISITES

Non-French speakers at any level, wishing to acquire the rules of oral and written communication, in order to improve their French language skills for professional purposes.

ORGANISATION OF TRAINING

PERMANENT ENTRIES AND EXITS

Mandatory requirement: to be a beneficiary of the RSA and/or to have followed OFII training.

Training provided throughout the year

5 groups of levels: A1.1/A1/A2/B1/B2 (CEFRL)

- 160 hours for level A1.1 based on a rhythm from 9h to 12h/week
- 200 hours for level A1, A2, B1 and B2 based on a rhythm of 9 h to 12 h/ week
- 50 hours, for social purposes, for people having difficulties with working (renewable if necessary)

PROCEDURES AND DEADLINES FOR ACCESS TO TRAINING

- 1) Applications sent by social workers and partners by e-mail

- 2) Passing placement tests provided by the training center
- 3) Enter training

The period of access to training varies according to the places available in the permanent entry and exit classes.

- Participatory pedagogy in compliance with the requirements of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)
- Courses delivered by qualified trainers.
- · Guided self-training
- Preparation for certifications: TCF/DELF A2/DELF B1/DELF B2 (CECRL)
- French as a Foreign Language modules
- Computer modules
- · Socio-professional workshops
